'ALL TOGETHER NOW'

LEAN IN:

- Q. Have you ever been part of something (sports team, school project, family event) that was incredibly unified? HOW did it feel?
- Q. WHAT do you think most limits our ability to live together in unity?
eg: *The need to always be right – single issue obsession – gossip?*
- Q. WHAT is the difference between UNITY and uniformity, union and unanimity?
- Q. HOW would you answer the question raised in (Amos 3:3)?

LOOK AT:

- Q. WHAT (Vs.1) is so *good and pleasant* about God's people being united?
- Q. WHY (Vs.2) is our unity pictured as being like *precious oil poured* out from head down and WHAT does Aaron have to do with it?
- Q. HOW (Vs.3) does the *dew of Hermon* illustrate the blessings that God promises us when we live together in unity?
(Ephesians 4:3) says we are "*Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.*"

- Q. HOW do you think we can we do exactly that?
- Q. HOW can we practice unity with others we may struggle with?

LIVE OUT:

- Q. WHERE do we draw our own personal lines of fellowship?
- Q. HOW do we go about agreeing to disagree at times in love and WHY (John 13:35) is this so important?
- Q. HOW do we determine which doctrines are essential and which are important, but not essential? WHAT criteria do we apply?
- Q. Given all our differences, HOW do we stay unified as a church?
