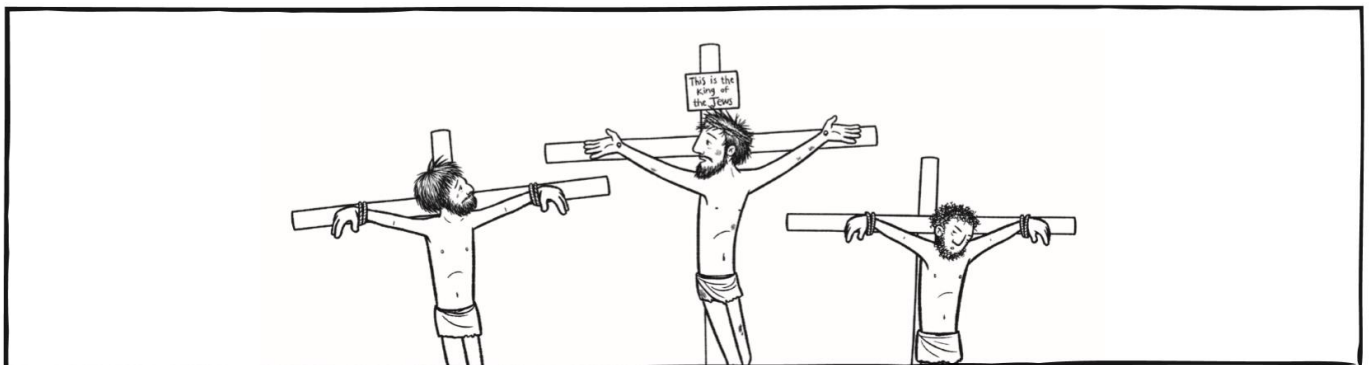

Big Idea: On the cross, we clearly see who Jesus is - forgiving the soldiers and saving the criminal - this is why he came.



3-5s

8-11s

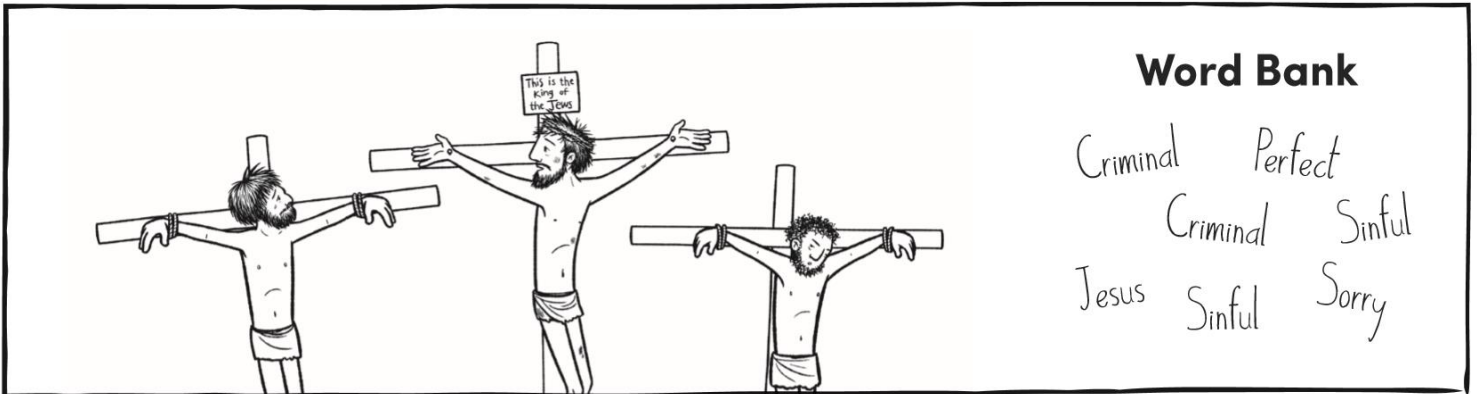
- What did Jesus do for the criminal on the cross?

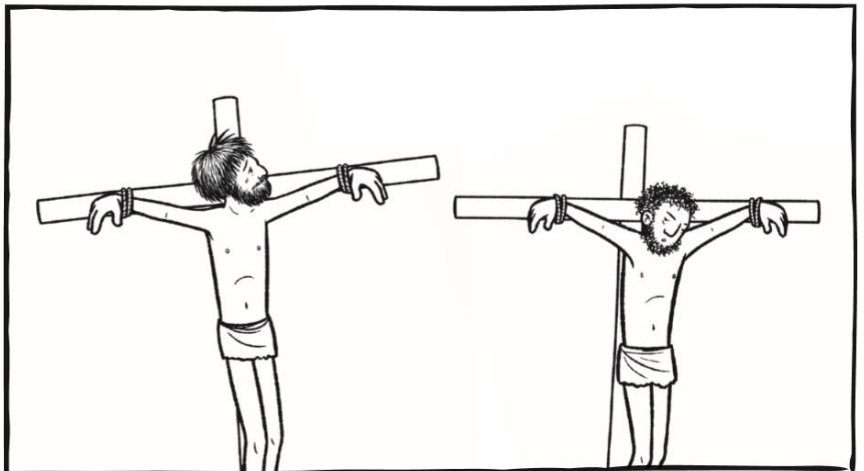

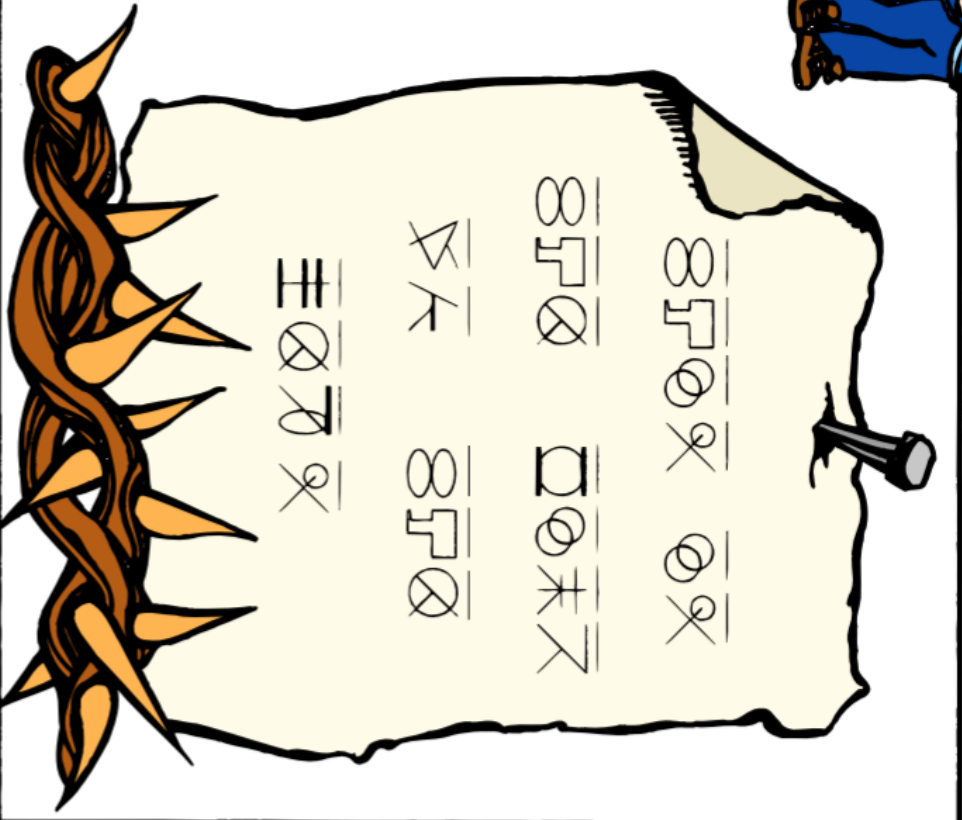

There was a sign placed above Jesus as he hung on the cross. It is written in 3 languages. Use the code below to read what the sign said:



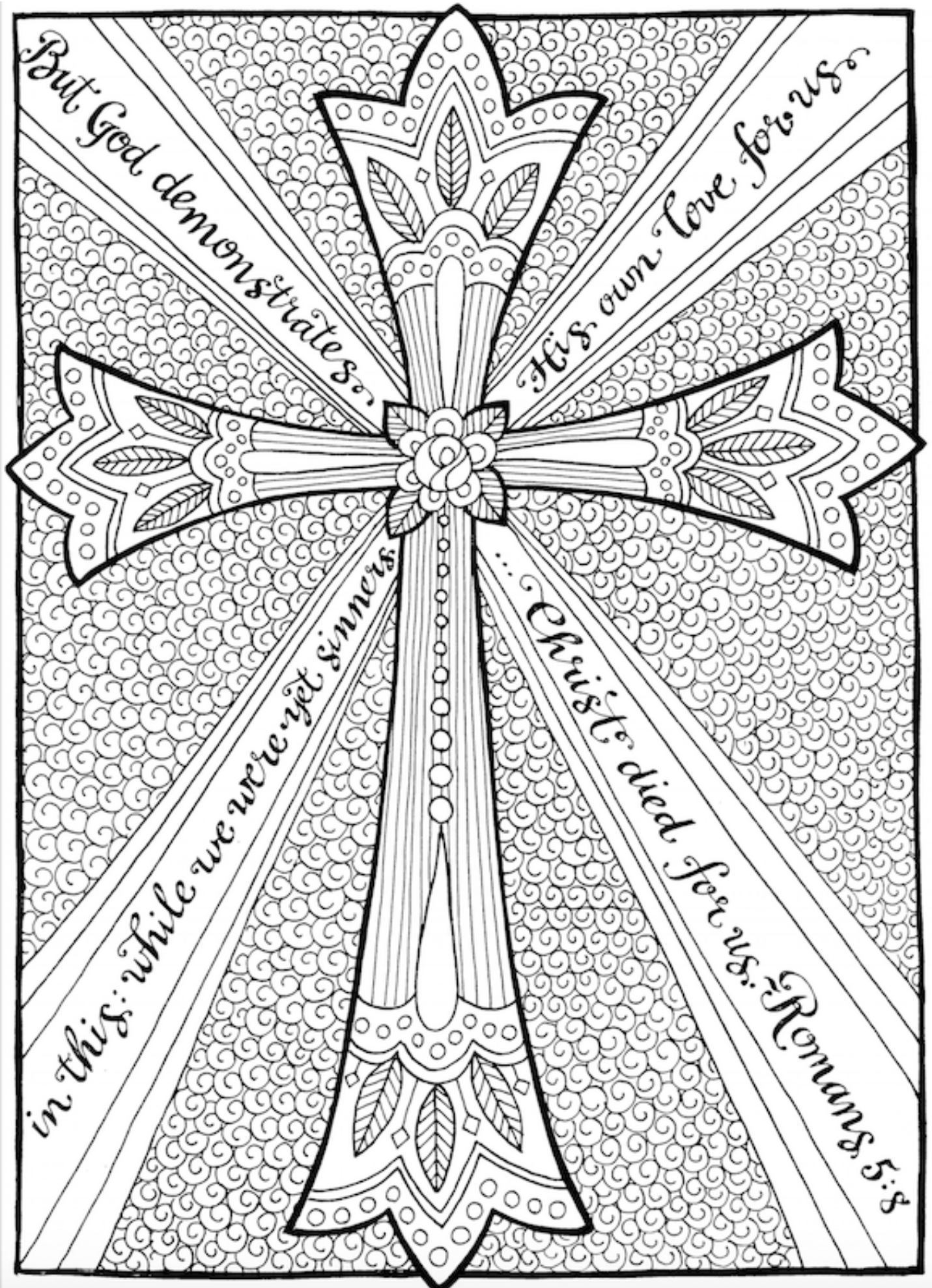
