Read Nehemiah 7:70-73

- Much was freely given, where did it come from?

Look over 1 Corinthians 12:27-31 and Ephesians 4:11 at the gifts we can have: where could you serve?

- Administration; Discernment; Evangelism; Encouragement; Faith; Giving; Helping; Knowledge; Shepherding; Service; Prophecy; Teaching; Wisdom
- Do you see one of these gifts in yourself, or does someone see this gift in you?
