Communicare has been tasked by the City Council with providing extra volunteers to help keep hospital beds and care settings freed up during the peak time of impact of the next wave of the virus, expected to be from the third week of January for 6-8 weeks. So, they need to recruit temporary volunteers more quickly than the usual route. The volunteers would be helping to keep people at home, freeing up hospital beds, by doing good neighbourly tasks (not personal or medical care) and making phone calls through two projects:

**Hello Southampton**, in which a volunteer signs up for an hour a week, when they make short check-in phone calls to a certain number of vulnerable people, (tablet or computer needed for logging in) *No DBS check required*.

**Best at Home**, where volunteers either run errands from the door like picking up prescriptions and some shopping, pop in to do simple tasks like make a sandwich, vacuum etc. *Current DBS check required if going into people's homes*
