## Choosing the Better Role

## Luke 10:38-42

Mary and Martha were sisters, but their response to Jesus' visit was quite different. Martha responded in the traditional way expected of a woman. Mary responded in a way that was much more conducive to her personal and spiritual growth.

- 1. **READ Luke 10:38-42**. What do you picture Martha doing as Jesus talks to Mary (*Luke 10:40*)? What do you think she is feeling?
- 2. Why does Martha complain to Jesus (*Luke 10:40*)? What does Martha think Jesus' expectations of her are?
- 3. How do you think Mary was feeling before Martha was upset? How do you think she feels after Martha gets upset?
- 4. Martha displays both positive and negative qualities. From your observation of her and of Jesus' comment what is her root problem?
- 5. Why hadn't Martha responded to her real need(s)?
- 6. What does Jesus mean by "one thing is needed" (Luke 10:42)?
- 7. To choose what is better is the second mark of true disciples. What qualities do you observe in people who, like Mary, "choose what is better"?
- 8. Which character in this story do you most closely relate to?
